Course Outline

Day 1: Unlock the power of Mobile Storytelling

- * How to plan and film photo stories, master camera settings and plan shot sizes.
- * Understand composition and lighting, write to pictures, work with story subjects, and produce visual media for social media.
- * Introduce apps, accessories, training, and workflows that allow field reporters to file high-quality multimedia reportage from smartphones.
- * Tips for using free apps to create snackable and sharable content for mobile consumers.

Day 2: Mastering the Building of Mobile Video

- * Master visual sequences from shot patterns and shot sizes that build visual sequences for video reports.
- * Improve mobile video production techniques by mastering the fundamentals of filmmaking, story planning and interviews.
- * Master mobile video camera to get great footage.
- * How to prepare questions and interview subjects to get great sound bites.
- * How to structure and plan a video story, as well as write scripts and record voice over narration.
- * Tips for improving story planning, script writing and on-camera pieces

Robb Montgomery is an international journalist and is the author of the IREX S.M.A.R.T. Media Lab - a training facility built for mobile media production.

He recently developed the mobile reporting training, technology and workflows used by hundreds of Radio Free Europe (RFE/RL) reporters and correspondents.

Montgomery's media development experience includes authoring curriculum and practicum for editorial filmmaking, social media, writing for the Web, and mobile multimedia programs in Egypt, Georgia, and Bosnia. He has taught visual editing to graduate students at the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University and currently contributes as a senior lecturer to the International Academy of Journalism in Hamburg.

Montgomery has worked as an editor for the Chicago Sun-Times and the Chicago Tribune and led large-scale redesign projects at several publications including the Chicago Sun-Times, Leadership, and The San Francisco Examiner.
